On Saturday,

29 June, 1867, Taylor's launched the *Thomas & Edward* for Burley's, then, on 1 July, they launched the 100 ton *Annie Lloyd* for the carriage of straw to Edward Lloyd's paper manufactory. The following year *Alice Lloyd* was laid down. The former won the 1870 Topsail class, beating *Bessie Hart*, and was 2nd in 1873, with the *Frank Lloyd* 3rd, while *Alice Lloyd* won the tops'l classes of 1869 and 1872.
