On Saturday,

29 June, 1867, Taylor's launched the Thomas & Edward for Burley's, then, on 1 July, they launched the 100 ton Annie Lloyd for the carriage of straw to Edward Lloyd's paper manufactory. The following year Alice Lloyd was laid down. The former won the 1870 Topsail class, beating Bessie Hart, and was 2nd in 1873, with the Frank Lloyd 3rd, while Alice Lloyd won the tops'l classes of 1869 and 1872.
