Mr. Edward Lloyd's Estate.

A Release by the beneficiaries of this estate was prepared by us some time ago by <sup>the</sup> instructions of the trustees, and the deed has now been executed by all parties except yourself. At the instance of Mr. Percy Lloyd and his trustees, a firm of accountants were employed to investigate the books ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> accounts of the trust, and to prepare a report thereon. This report states that each of the beneficiaries has received his or her full share of the estate exclusive of the securities and balance of cash retained by the Executors to meet the annuities. Annexed to the report are copies of the trust accounts, and no point of any importance arises upon them. We have no hesitation in saying that matters are all in order, and that all the beneficiaries, (several of whom we represented in reference to the deed), may quite safely sign it.

We therefore send you the deed herewith, and if you approve it, we shall be obliged by your signing it opposite the last seal but three, where your name is written in pencil, in the presence of a witness who should sign his or her name, adding address and description underneath the <sup>-last-</sup> attestation clause but one overleaf.

return with the deed.

If there is any explanation or information which you require, we shall be happy to supply it.

We may mention that the draft of the deed was approved by four separate Solicitors acting for some of the beneficiaries.
